Vocabulary List

Grades Pre-K to 2

1. decorate to add to an object or space to make it interesting or attractive
2. detail a specific part of an object one may not notice when looking at the object as a whole
3. hook a curved device usually attached to a surface for holding objects
4. museum a building in which objects of interest are displayed
5. object something that may be seen and felt, such as chairs and tables
6. tin a soft bluish-white metal used to make objects
7. pitcher a container for holding and pouring liquids that usually has a lip or spout and a handle
8. utensil an implement used to prepare and/or eat food
9. weaving making fabric by interlacing yarn or thread
10. wool a fabric made from sheep hair
